On your initial visit, a brief background check will be performed and a profile set up. Afterward, each time you check in at the Kroc Center, you will be asked to show a photo ID and your Family Y membership card.

As always, your Metro Membership allows you unlimited privileges at all nine of our CSRA program facilities, including our newest location at 945 Broad Street in downtown Augusta in the historic YMCA building (formerly Health Central). We hope you will grow stronger and healthier by participating in the hundreds of group and individual fitness opportunities each week, strengthening your family in our family-friendly activities, and enjoying some cooling leisure time in our three indoor pools, two outdoor pools and water park.

Our members are our most valuable asset and it is through your support that we are able to keep our doors open to whoever needs a place to go to help them be more healthy, confident, connected and secure. Our partnership with the Kroc Center is an example of how we work side-by-side with our neighbors to make sure everyone, regardless of age, income or background, has the opportunity to learn, grow and thrive.
