Service Summary: The VOLUNTEER is responsible for assisting in teaching swim skills as taught by the swim instructor and to teach the Five Core Values: Caring, Honesty, Respect, Responsibility, and Faith.

Service Requirements:

- Ages 14 & up
- Prior teaching experience not required.
- Some prior swim experience preferred.
- Treat all program participants with respect regardless of race, religion, or culture.
- Possess energy, enthusiasm, and a positive attitude.
- Communicate swim skills to participants as instructed by swim instructor
- Use positive techniques of guidance, including positive reinforcement and encouragement rather than competition, comparison or criticism.
- Portray a positive role model for youth by maintaining an attitude of respect, loyalty, patience, integrity, courtesy, and maturity.
- Commit to assisting the same time each class for a total of 8 classes at a minimum. Sessions are 2 days per week for 4 weeks August – May and 4 classes (Monday – Thursday) for 2 weeks June – July.
- Support the authority of the swim instructor.
- Wear a one-piece bathing suit.
- Report any injuries and/or unsafe conditions immediately to the sports department.
- Adapt to changing work conditions.
- Performs all other duties as assigned
